## Configure CAS Settings for a JD FlexApp

When you add a FlexApp to Unite for a JD or LLB degree, you can configure settings to manage the LSAC Credential Assembly Service (CAS) for international candidates. You can also select whether your school will waive the LSAT requirement for candidates who submit applications. The following table provides a description of each JD CAS setting for international candidates.

Setting	Description
Accepted	The <b>Accepted</b> setting indicates your school accepts but does not require AACRAO evaluations with CAS reports for international candidates.
Do Not Participate	The <b>Do Not Participate</b> setting indicates your school does not accept AACRAO evaluations with CAS reports for international candidates.
Recommended	The <b>Recommended</b> setting indicates your school prefers but does not require AACRAO evaluations with CAS reports for international candidates.
Required	The <b>Required</b> setting indicates your school requires a full AACRAO evaluation with CAS reports for international candidates.

Once an application cycle end date expires, you cannot edit CAS settings for the application.

## To configure CAS settings

- 1. Open a browser and log on to Unite.
- 2. On the main menu, click UTILITIES.

- 3. Click the *Form Design* tab.
- 4. Verify you are on the *FlexApp* grid.
- 5. In the **Name** column, click the FlexApp you want to configure.
- 6. Verify you are on the *Settings* tab.
- 7. Click and expand the *Credential Assembly Service* section.
- 8. Click Edit
- 9. Specify the CAS settings.
- 10. Click Save
- 11. Preview the FlexApp and verify your changes.
- 12. Click Submit
- 13. Click **X** to close the *Edit FlexApp* window.
